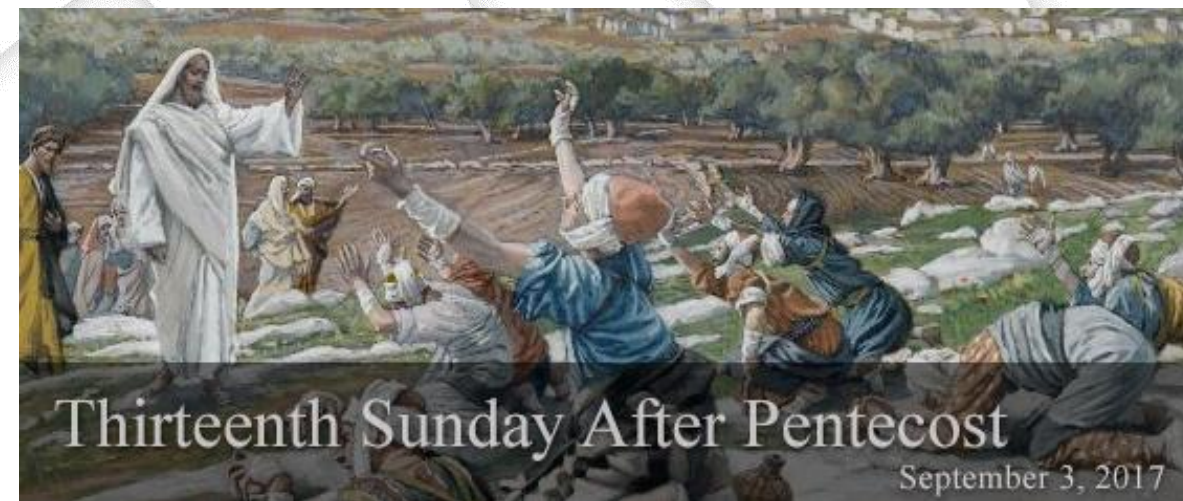


NATIVITY of the BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

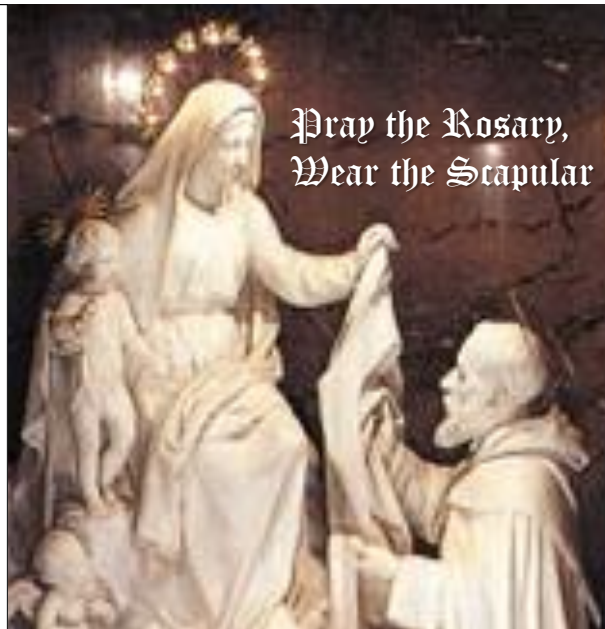
HURRICANE HARVEY and QUEEN OF ANGELS, DICKINSON, TX
