Ember Days of September

The week following the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14), features the so-called "Ember Days" of September (the English word "ember" being a permutation of the Latin title *Quattuor Temporum Septembris*).

This special week of September on the liturgical calendar is one of the four seasonal weeks (thus, *Quattuor Temporalis*, or Four Seasons) that have Ember Days which are related to the harvest of the fruits of the earth, which through fasting and penance we pray will be bountiful.
