**SAINT THERESE OF THE CHILD JESUS**

October 3

**T**HERESE MARTIN (1873-97) entered the Carmelite convent in Lisieux, France, at the age of 15. Her simple but heroic religious life of nine years was dedicated to saving souls and to praying for priests. The young Carmelite longed to lead her hidden life of prayer in a pagan land, but illness kept her in France. Yet so well did she fulfill the essential vocation of a missionary that in 1927, two years after her canonization, Pope Pius declared her the patron of all missions, together with St. Francis Xavier, Apostle of the Orient.
