SAINT MARTIN OF TOURS
 November 11

SON OF AN officer in the Roman army, Martin of Tours (c. 316-97) was already a catechumen when he was conscripted into the imperial horse-guards at the age of 15. The famous incident in which Martin cut his cloak in two with his sword to clothe a beggar, took place while he was on garrison duty at Amiens. Soon after this, he was baptized, left the army, and went to serve Bishop Hilary of Poitiers as a cleric in minor orders. Later he founded a famous monastery at Ligugé. When St. Hilary died, the people of Tours made Martin his successor, virtually by force. During his long episcopate, Martin not only organized parish life in his diocese, but journeyed throughout Gaul, evangelizing the French countryside, and earning the title, "Apostle of France."

Annual Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary: The annual consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary according to the "True Devotion" way of St. Louis De Montfort will be held on Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. There is a 5-week preparation period of readings and prayers recommended for making the consecration. Those wishing to make or renew their consecration need to begin this preparation on Nov. 4. The book *Consecration to Mary* by Fr. Helmut Libietis is available through the [Angelus Press](#).

Consecration to the Immaculata: Those interested may also consider the Consecration to the Immaculata according to St. Maximilian Kolbe. Preparatory exercises include a short reading everyday for 13 days. Once consecrated a short prayer is to be recited each day along with the wearing of the Miraculous Medal. Please consider this consecration as the graces are abundant and the requirements are simple. Preparation should begin on November 25 with the consecration also being held on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8. Preparatory booklets for the Consecration are on order now and will be available soon for \$1 each in our bookstore.
