SAINT JOSAPHAT
 November 14

JOSAPHAT, apostle and a martyr of Church unity, was baptized John Kuncevyk. When he was 16, in 1595, the Ruthenian Church, to which he belonged, was officially united with Rome. As a young apprentice-merchant with a monastic vocation, he devoted his spare time to learning Church Slavonic, in order to assist more intelligently at the Liturgy and to recite some of the Divine Office each day. As soon as possible he entered the monastery of the Holy Trinity at Vilna. Made Archbishop of Polotsk In 1617, he fought tirelessly to preserve the union with Rome against fierce opposition from many of the people and a schismatic hierarchy. He was beaten to death in a riot incited by his opponents in 1623. St. Josaphat is one of the patrons of Poland.

Annual Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary: The annual consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary according to the "True Devotion" way of St. Louis De Montfort will be held on Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. There is a 5-week preparation period of readings and prayers recommended for making the consecration. Those wishing to make or renew their consecration need to have begun this preparation on Nov. 4. Consecration to the Immaculata: Those interested may also consider the Consecration to the Immaculata according to St. Maximilian Kolbe. Preparatory exercises include a short reading everyday for 13 days. Once consecrated a short prayer is to be recited each day along with the wearing of the Miraculous Medal. Please consider this consecration as the graces are abundant and the requirements are simple. Preparation should begin on November 25 with the consecration also being held on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8. Preparatory booklets for the Consecration are on order now and will be available soon for \$1 each in our bookstore.
