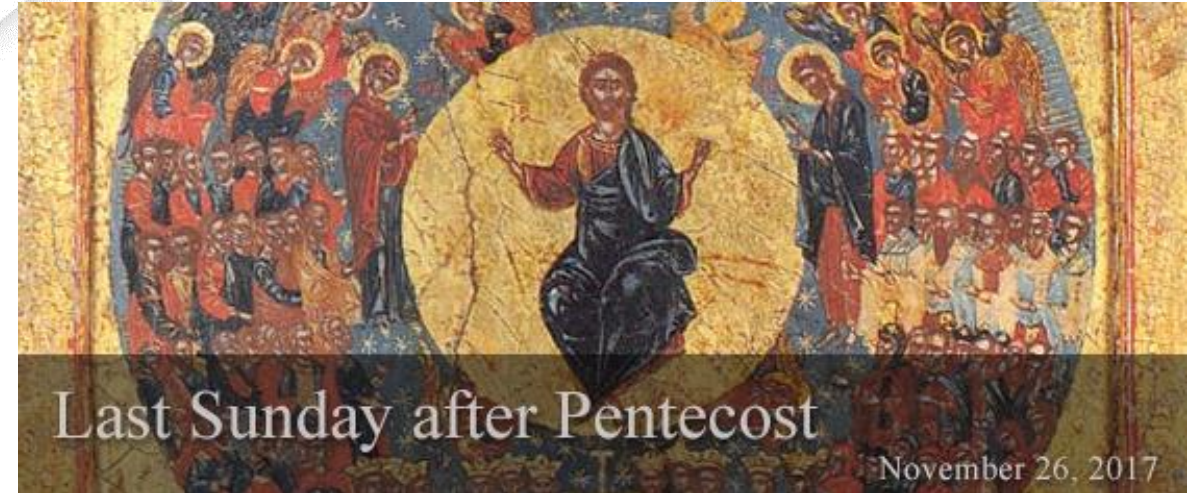

Annual Consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary

The annual consecration to the Blessed Virgin Mary according to the "True Devotion" way of St. Louis De Montfort will be held on Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Those wishing to make or renew their consecration need to have begun this preparation on Nov. 4.

Consecration to the Immaculata

Those interested may also consider the Consecration to the Immaculata according to St. Maximilian Kolbe. Preparatory exercises include a short reading everyday for 13 days. Once consecrated a short prayer is to be recited each day along with the wearing of the Miraculous Medal. Please consider this consecration as the graces are abundant and the requirements are simple. Preparation should begin on November 25 with the consecration also being held on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8. Booklets for the Consecration are on order now and will be available soon for \$1 each in our bookstore.
