FEAST of OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

December 12



IN THE SUMMIT of a hill a few miles north of Mexico City, our Lady appeared to Juan Diego, a poor Aztec Indian convert, in December, 1531. In order that the Spanish Archbishop Zumárraga of Mexico might have faith in the apparitions, Mary made roses bloom on the cold, arid hillside, and impressed a picture of herself upon Juan Diego's roughly woven mantle. Devotion to our Lady of Guadalupe has helped to weld into a nation various peoples of Mexico; and her shrine has never been closed, even during the most bitter conflicts between Church and State in that country.
